### **FINA 10km Marathon Swimming World Cup**

Angela Maurer (GER) and Vladimir Dyatchin (RUS), the best of the 2007 edition

**Lausanne, October 22, 2007** – After eleven races, the German Angela Maurer and the Russian Vladimir Dyatchin conquered the first FINA 10km Marathon Swimming World Cup organised in 2007. The last race took place last Saturday, on October 20, 2007 in the Caribbean sea in Cancun (MEX), and the two leaders of the general standings finished respectively second of the men's and women's competitions to validate the final victories.

In the men's race, Valerio Cleri (ITA) confirmed his excellent season with a fourth victory and a third place of the general standings. His team-mate Nicola Bolzonello, third, obtained his first podium in a FINA competition.

In the women's race, Britta Kamrau-Corestein (GER), five-time second this year, won her first 2007 gold medal. The experimented Jana Pechanova (CZE) completed the podium.
